Review of why a Rescue Pumper By Dave Bourgoin and Bruce Appell – manpower, calls that turn into extrications. Plan to put one on each side of town. Would allow us to purchase a support truck rather than a large truck when replacing Rescue 8 eventually.

Thompsonville rescue pumper close to what we want according to Post.

Review the wants of AVFD

If bid not awarded by 12/2012 will be subject to 2013 engine with more robust electronics and increased cost

Discuss leasing options. In the past, the town does not lease. Will have \$400K July 1

If we bought two vehicles at the same time, there isn't much savings. Maybe 1 or 2 percent.

G. Post to take our requirements, including a copy of the specs from E-10 and come up with a drawing and rough cost

Why Seagrave? Sole source – they build everything – best warranty, best stainless steel construction

Seagrave provides 3 day training for Mechanics. Town would pay travel and room and board – generally held twice a year.
